All applicants are required to audition on snare drum, mallets, and timpani. Please note that drum set is not an option. In addition to the lists below, applicants may be asked to sight read. Applicants are highly encouraged to audition in person at UCLA. However, an applicant who is unable to attend on-campus auditions may submit a video audition. Video auditions may be edited between selections, but not within a selection.

First Year Applicants

Please prepare the following:

- **Snare Drum**

1. Long Closed Roll (see below).

2. "Drum Corps on Parade" from *14 Modern Contest Solos* by John Pratt. Play from the beginning to the downbeat of measure 28.
3. "Study #32" from *Intermediate Snare Drum Studies* by Mitchell Peters.

- **Marimba**

1. "Gigue" from *Partita No. 3 in E Major for Violin Solo* by J. S. Bach.
2. A four-mallet solo or etude of the applicant's own selection.

Please note that applicants should select repertoire that positively presents their musical and technical abilities. The audition should demonstrate the applicant's knowledge of style, quality of tone, musicality, and technique. An applicant who chooses repertoire considered "advanced" may risk not fully representing their musical abilities.

1. Exercises 26 and 27 from *Modern Method for Timpani* by Saul Goodman.

- **Marimba**

1. "Presto" from *Sonata No. 1 in G Minor for Violin Solo* by J. S. Bach. Play from the beginning to the end of the first section.

- **Marimba or Vibraphone**

1. A four-mallet solo or etude of the applicant's own selection.

Please note that applicants should select repertoire that positively presents their musical and technical abilities. The audition should demonstrate the applicant's knowledge of style, quality of tone, musicality, and technique. An applicant who chooses repertoire considered "advanced" may risk not fully representing their musical abilities.

1. *Sorcerer's Apprentice* by Dukas, rehearsal 17-24.

- **Timpani**

1. "Etude No. 45" from *Fundamental Method for Timpani* by Mitchell Peters.
2. *Symphony No. 9* by Beethoven, first movement, 20 measures after R to the end.

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Audition:

Please note that you will be asked to provide a video recording of a concert-style multiple percussion solo of your own selection that best demonstrates your level of proficiency. This video recording will be due via the Accepted platform also used to schedule auditions a few weeks before your audition. More details will be provided if invited to final round auditions. Video submissions must not be edited within any individual movement or piece.

Please also prepare the following:

2. Study #17 from *Advanced Snare Drum Studies* by Mitchell Peters.
3. *Scheherazade* by Rimsky-Korsakov, third movement D to E, fourth movement P to R, T to U.
4. *Lt. Kijé* by Prokofiev, first movement, rehearsal 1 to 2.

- **Marimba**

1. "Preludio" from *Partita No. 3 in E Major for Violin Solo* by J. S. Bach.

- **Marimba or Vibraphone**

1. A four-mallet solo or etude of the applicant's own selection.

- **Xylophone**

1. *Porgy and Bess* by Gershwin, opening.

- **Timpani**

1. "Etude No. 53" from *Fundamental Method for Timpani* by Mitchell Peters.

3. *Symphony No. 4* by Tchaikovsky, first movement, 4 measures before T to U.
