Music MM Prescreening Requirements

Select 3 works that are in contrasting styles (chosen from Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Impressionistic, 20th Century, and 21st Century). You may bring collaborative partners, or they can be assigned to you, with rehearsal time offered from UCLA students and/or graduates.

- 1. One work must be a solo piece or excerpt up to 5 minutes, memory optional.
- 2. One work must be a complete Instrumental Sonata or a selected movement or movements from a Sonata.
- 3. One work must be a complete instrumental concerto or selected movement(s).
- 4. One work must be with a singer (one song, set of songs, aria or song cycle)
- 5. The 5th work can be of another genre, or one of the above examples in another style.

Music MM Audition Requirements

Bring 5 works that are in contrasting styles (chosen from Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Impressionistic, 20th Century, and 21st Century) You may bring collaborative partners, or they can be assigned to you, with rehearsal time offered from UCLA students and/or graduates.
